FY22 GRANTS - MS Airports

- **Total Federal Grant Funding for FY2022: 105 Grants - \$38M**
 - AIP Entitlement \$15M
 - ARPA - \$13M
 - AIP Discretionary \$9.5M
 - **BIL \$729K (out of \$20M)**
 - Supplemental Discretionary \$59K

FY23 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) Funding

- BIL Funding FY22-26
- FY22 ATP (Terminals) – GTR, FY22 FCT (Towers) – TUP
- FY23 ATP NOFO in September 2022 (30 day app period)
- FY23 AIG (Infrastructure) Funding (in addition to AIP)
 - Small Hubs – Approx. \$3M - \$4M
 - Non Hubs – Approx. \$1M
 - GA – (\$110K, \$159K, or \$295k)
 - Unused FY2022 funds are also available
- **JAN-ADO can issue BIL grants starting November 2022**



FY23 Grants Schedule

- Call for Pre-applications has been sent.
- Pre-applications are due to ADO/MDOT by **Oct 1, 2022.**
 - ALDOT deadline is Sep 23
 - Include Separate Projects for BIL/AIG Grants
- JAN ADO to send **GO Letters in December 2022.**
- JAN ADO expects the Federal Register Notice to identify **mid-April** as the due date for **entitlement grant** applications. This has not, however, been set.
- JAN ADO deadline for planned **discretionary grants – June 15, 2023**
