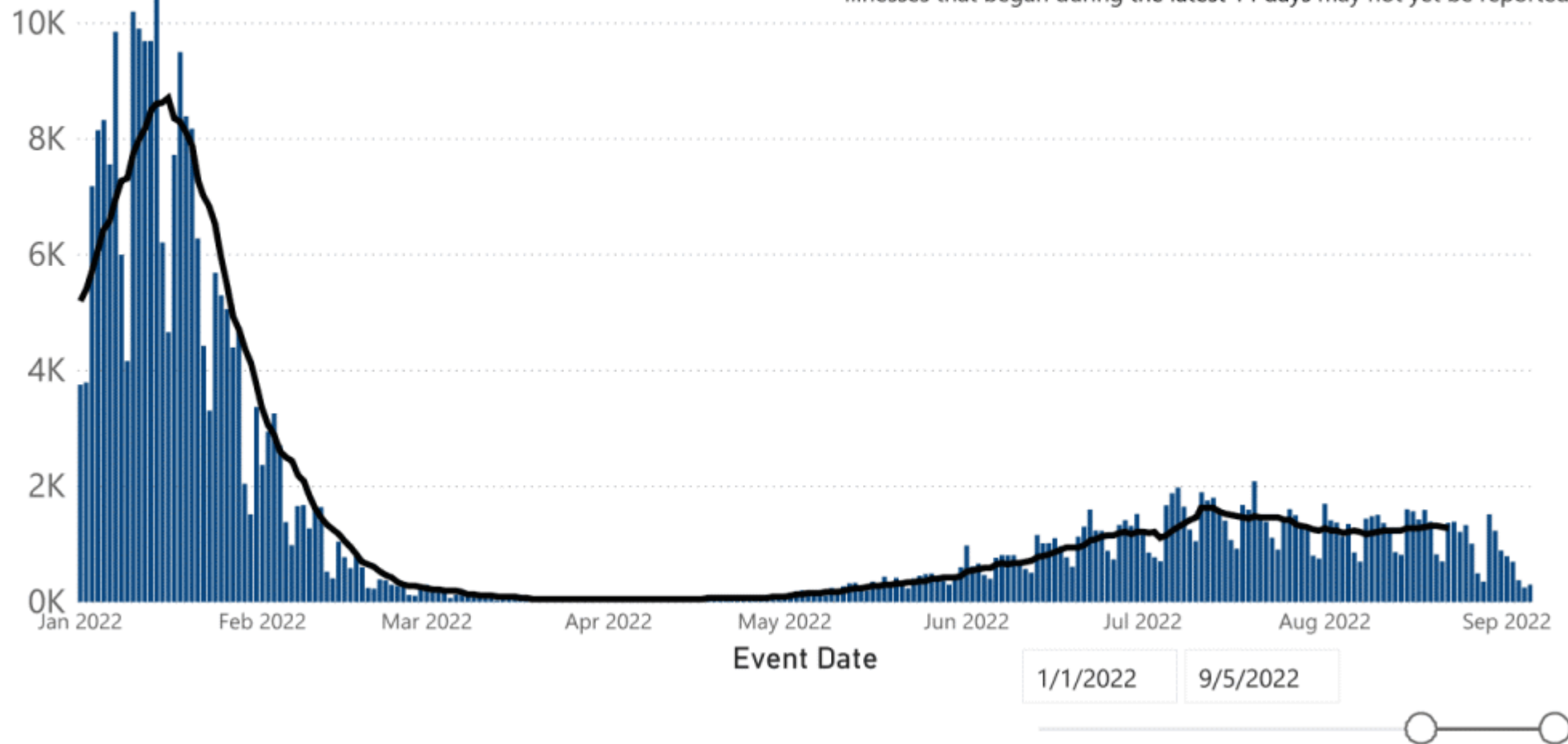
COVID-19 Cases by Date* through September 5, 2022**, Mississippi

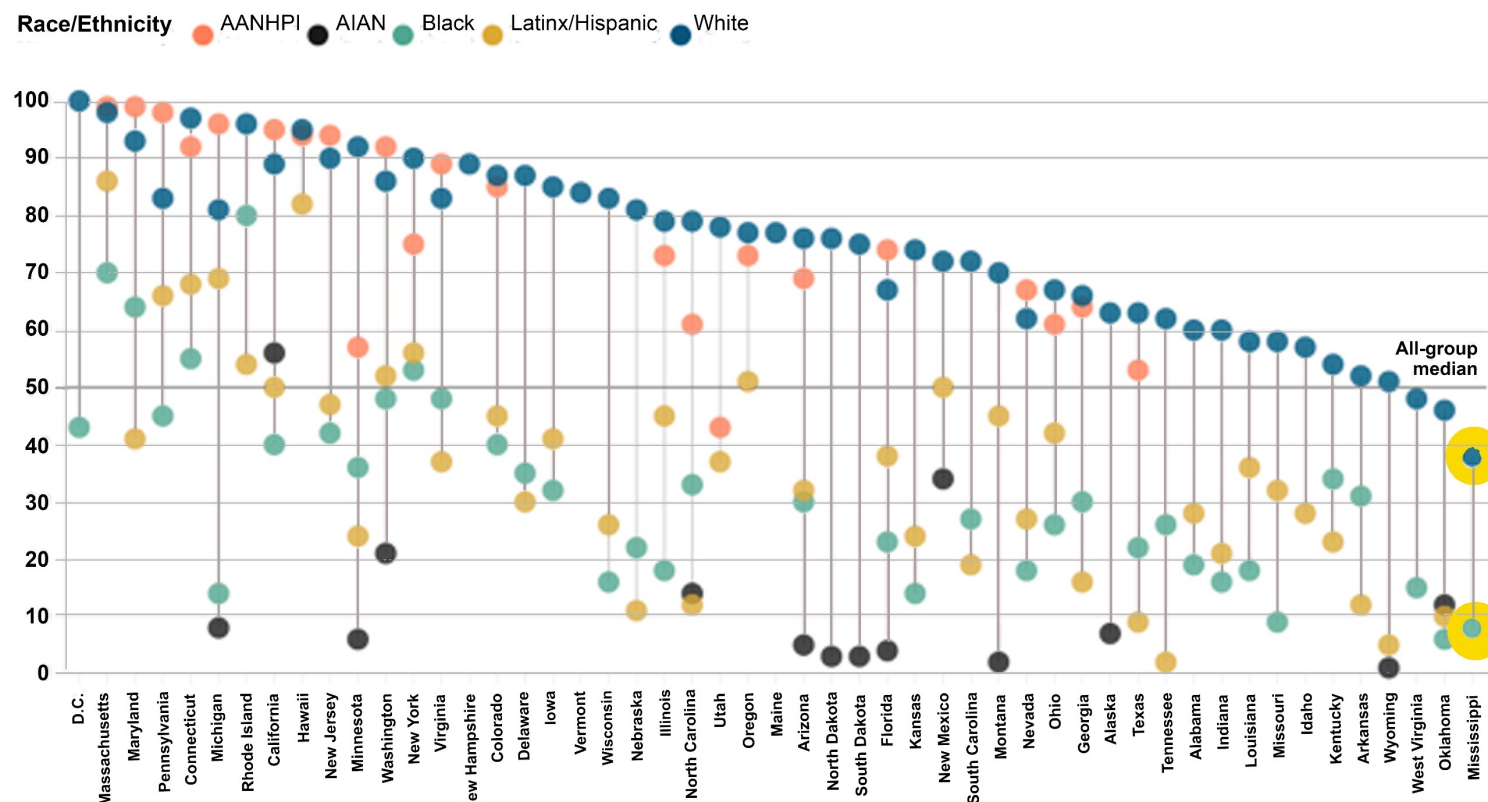
- **Giving everyone a ticket**
