 - Some additional funding from interest
- Applications Submitted per Mode
 - 29 Airport, 5 Port, 7 Rail
- Projects Awarded per Mode
 - 14 Airport, 5 Port, 3 Rail
- Funding Awarded per Mode
 - Airport - \$5,387,031
 - Port - \$2,999,323
 - Rail - \$2,865,500

Strategic Multi-Modal Investments

• Year Three

- \$18 Million Fund for Airports, Ports, and Railroads
 - Special Session - Senate Bill 2049
- ***Tentative*** Application Schedule
 - Application Solicitation - October 1, 2025
 - Application Deadline – November 14, 2025
- ***Tentative*** Awards Announced
 - Early 2026

Strategic Multi-Modal Investments

• House Bill 1

- From the collections that exceed \$0.18 per gallon, 2.75% goes to SMIF
- Estimated SMIF portion:
 - FY 2026 – \$1.96M
 - FY 2027 – \$3.92M
 - FY 2028 – \$5.88M
 - FY 2029 – \$5.88M
 - FY 2030 – \$6.53M

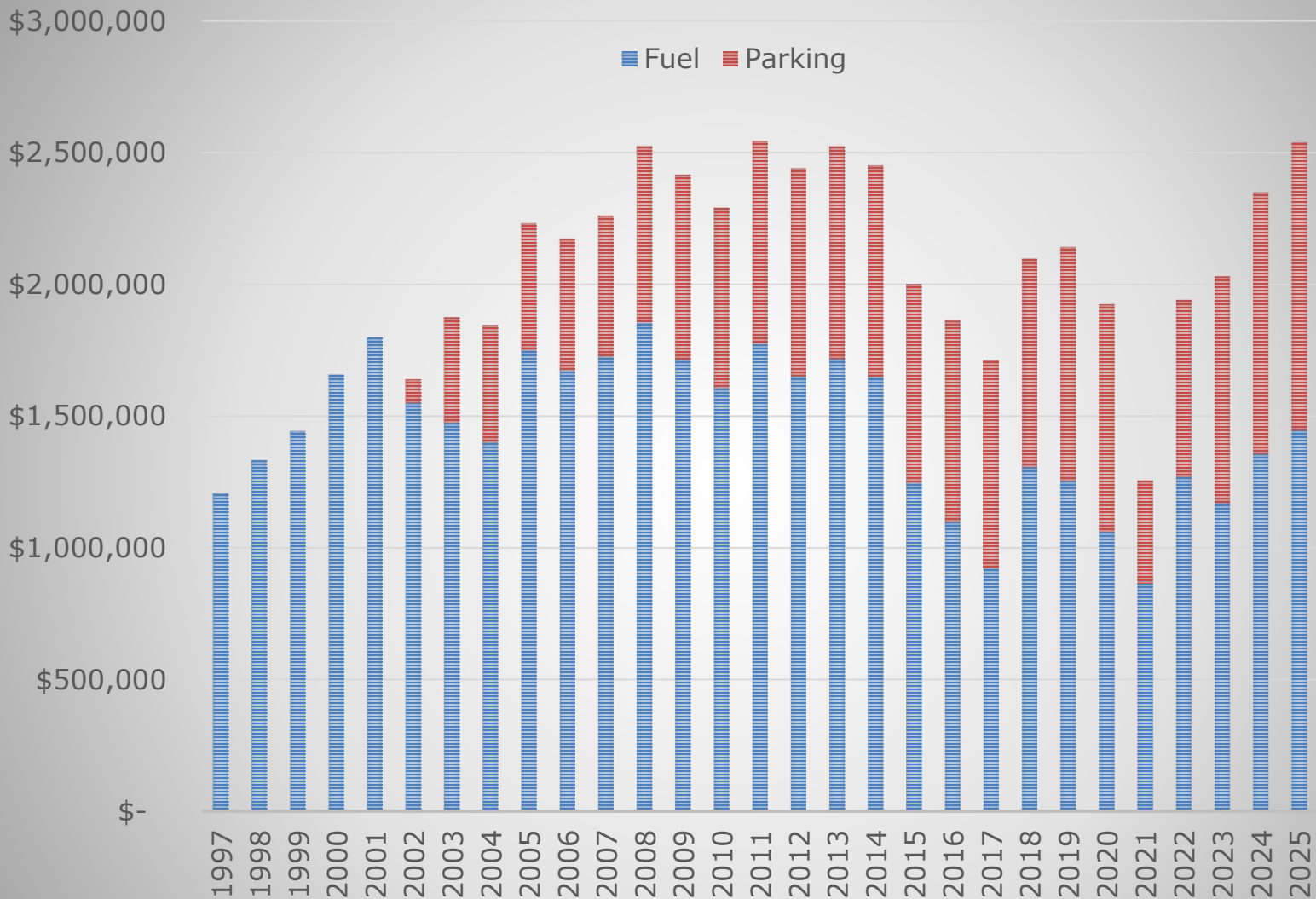
Strategic Multi-Modal Investments

- Federal FY2024
 - Issued 35 AIP matching grants; \$1,172,366
 - Issued 22 AIG matching grants; \$604,788
- Federal FY 2025 FAA AIP matching grants
 - Issued 22 totaling \$197,573
 - August 12 Commission
 - Pending 23 totaling \$794,049
 - Should be on an October Commission agenda
- Federal FY 2025 FAA BIL-AIG matching grants
 - Issued 27 totaling \$404,379
 - August 12 Commission
 - Pending 18 totaling \$284,769
 - Should be on an October Commission agenda

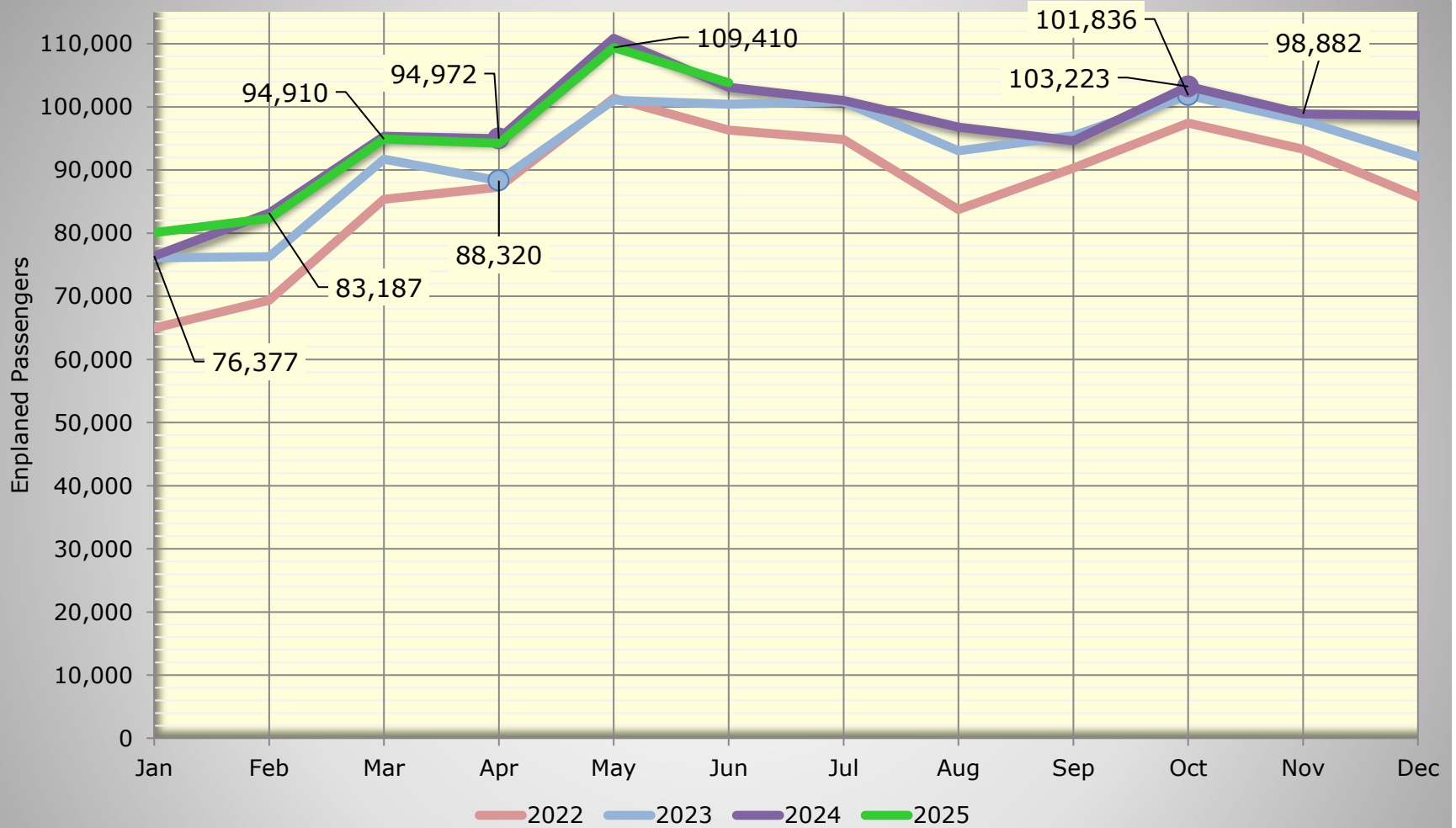
FAA Matching Funds – AIP/BIL-AIG

- FY2026 Multimodal Grants
 - Awarded 17 projects totaling \$3,756,446
- Strategic Multi-Modal
 - Awarded 5 projects totaling \$5,387,031
- FAA AIP and BIL/AIG matching grants
 - Issued 49 totaling \$601,952
 - August 12 Commission
 - Pending 41 totaling \$1,078,818
 - Should be on an October Commission agenda
- Reimbursements for State FY 2025
 - Processed 256 totaling \$6,948,729
 - 47 were finals
